



Equipment Operator - Laborer Position Overview

The selected candidate will perform maintenance repairs throughout the Town limits in the areas of streets, sidewalks, parks, playgrounds, trails, pathways, vehicle fleet, building interiors and exteriors; trash and debris removal, traffic signals, street lights, bridges, ROW, drainage and detention facilities, and may also assist in the areas of the Town's public water supply and distribution systems and wastewater collection systems utilizing hand held and heavy equipment to complete these tasks.

The position requires knowledge and operation of vehicles and heavy equipment utilized in the daily operations of the Public Works department. This equipment ranges in size from full sized pickup/utility trucks to skid steer loaders, large wheel loaders, tandem axle dump trucks with manual transmissions and medium duty snow and ice trucks. This position demands physical exertion using both hand and power tools, working outside in varying weather conditions and temperatures ranging from very hot to extreme cold, heavy lifting, and basic computer skills. State of Colorado Certifications in drinking water and sewer collection operations a plus; however, the Town is willing to train the successful candidate for certification in both disciplines. Applicants must possess a valid Colorado driver's license and insurable driving record. A Commercial Drivers License (CDL) with a Class B and air brake endorsements is required within 3 months of hire date. The applicant must also possess a high school diploma or GED. Work schedules vary and may include weekend, holiday, on-call duty and overtime as required and posted. Wages are dependent on experience and certification, if any.
